### **Sub: 15<sup>th</sup> Hockey India Sub Junior Women National Championship 2025**

Dear Sir/ Madam,

We are pleased to inform you that the 15<sup>th</sup> Hockey India Sub Junior Women National Championship 2025 is provisionally scheduled to be held at Ranchi, Jharkhand, from 03 July to 14 July 2025.

#### **Players born on or after 1 January 2009 are eligible to participate in the said championship.**

You are requested to note the important details regarding the conduct of the 15th Hockey India Sub Junior Women National Championship 2025: -

#### **1. Eligibility**

##### **1.1 Team**

- a) Only Hockey India registered State/ UT/ NCT Member Units are eligible to participate in the above-mentioned championship.

##### **1.2 Athlete**

- a) A Player will only be allowed to participate in one of the categories i.e. Senior OR Junior OR Sub Junior National Championship.

#### **2. Ranking in Pool**

Teams will be ranked in a pool basis the ranking achieved in the 14th Hockey India Sub Junior Women National Championship 2024.

*As you are aware Hockey India has introduced the Hockey India Member Unit Portal. It is now mandatory for every Member Unit those who are participating in National Championships, to register their players and provide complete information related to players on the online portal. Any Member Unit which fails to register their teams on the portal before the given deadline will not be allowed to register their team on the portal and hence not allowed to participate in National Championships. The link to the portal & login details have been already sent vide letter no. HI/HIMUP/2019 dated 06 September 2019.*

**We are sharing the below few important details to be followed while using the Hockey India Member Unit Portal: -**

- Hockey India has shared a Login ID and Password with the respective Member Unit over email.
- You are requested to ensure that you do not share your Login and Password with anyone apart from the President/ General Secretary.
- Each Member Unit would be responsible for all the data entered in their respective Portal.

- Each Member Unit is liable for strict disciplinary action if there is any breach of security of Data available on the Portal.
- It is critical for each Member Unit to follow the deadlines specified for National Championships. Deadlines will not be extended in any case and failure to submission of the necessary information for the National Championship will result in automatic disqualification from the respective National Championship.
- Documentation in any form will not be accepted over email for any National Championship.

Team Entry Form needs to be submitted on the Online Portal by **21 June 2025**, failing which Member unit will not be allowed to register their team on the Portal and subsequently not allowed to participate in the National Championship.

You are requested to confirm participation and also deposit the participation fee of Rs.500/- in favour of Hockey India and submit the payment details on the email – [ashish@hockeyindia.org](mailto:ashish@hockeyindia.org) by **27 May 2025**.

**All teams will consist of 22 persons (18 Players and 4 Officials, which should include a Team Manager, a Coach, a Physiotherapist & a Medical Doctor who will be provided with a certificate) and must bring the following:**

1. Two playing kit uniforms in different colours with Bold and Visible Shirt Numbers and names, including two different colour stockings as per FIH regulations. (Details of the same need to be submitted on the Online Portal).
2. One set must comprise at least 80% single colour per piece. Goalkeeper shirts must comprise different colours to both primary and alternate colours of the shirt. (Details of the same need to be submitted on the Online Portal). It is mandatory to have playing skirts as the playing uniform. **Shorts will not be allowed for Women category events.**
3. It is mandatory to have 1 female support staff with the respective participating team in case of the Women National Championship.
4. Protection gear for the penalty corner must be used.
5. Track Suit for the March Past.
6. It is mandatory for teams to arrive at the venue 2 days before their first match of the National Championships.
7. It is mandatory for the Manager and Coach of the participating team to attend the Event Briefing, which shall be held one day before the start of the National Championship at 1400 hours.
8. The Team Entry Form submitted on the Online portal must be checked properly prior to submission (certificates will not be reissued for incorrect spelling, submitted/verified by the State/ Team Manager).
9. In case a player registered with any other state/member unit is playing for your team, please obtain the necessary NOC from that state/member unit at least 3 weeks in advance. Please be aware that without receipt of the NOC, Hockey India under the Tournament Regulations, will not permit the

player to participate in the tournament. ***(Out of 18 players, only 4 players would be allowed to obtain NOC from other Registered Member / State Units).***

It is mandatory for the participating team to be in the proper kit with the correct shirt numbers and colours, failing which they will be penalized. Also, it is mandatory for a team to carry two sets of different colour socks for their matches (to avoid any colour clash), and all playing 18 in the team will need to wear the same uniform for their match.

***It is also mandatory for all the players to carry at least 2 Government Photo IDs, which need to be presented to the Hockey India representative at the time of the Manager's Meeting at the event venue for verification. Players without photo identity cards will not be permitted to participate in the National Championship. The same should be informed to all the players well in advance by Member Units.***

As per Hockey India Rules, in case any team/s withdraws up to 1 week prior to the start of the tournament, then strict action will be taken against the Member Unit. In case any team fails to turn up without any intimation at least 1 week prior to the start of the tournament, then strict action will be taken against the Member Unit.

Please also note that in case any player is found to be overage, he can be banned for a period of one year and a fine imposition of Rs.50,000/-, which will have to be paid by the Member Unit, to be followed by action against the Team Management and the Member Unit. If a forged birth proof OR certificate is provided, then a fine of Rs. 10,000/- per player will be imposed, which will have to be paid by the respective Member Unit.

Members are advised that any breaches of the Hockey India Code of Conduct by any Player, Coach, or Manager or any violence or indent of violence against a member of another team or Official on or off the field will result in strict action against the Member Unit.
